The MICCA Preview show came into existence several years ago as a way for MICCA Bands to perform their show for each other in a non-competitive environment prior to starting the MICCA season.

Each band may perform all or PART of their field show for two judges---one visual, and one music.

Following their performance, the band will be led to the gym for a 15-minute clinic with the judges who just observed them.

While one judge is talking to the students, the other judge will talk to the staff and then vice-versa.

NO STARS will be awarded and NO MEDALS will be given. Each band will receive a participation plaque. Each band will receive a visual and music tape from the judges as well as a videotape of their performance.
