## General Information

College Scholarships are awarded to CHS graduating seniors who will be attending a 4-year or 2-year institution for whom music has played an important role.

1. Scholarships are awarded each year at the CHS Spring Pops Concert. Those not in attendance will be notified individually. Should there be no Spring Pops Concert, alternative means of award will be implemented.
2. The number and value of the awards will be based upon the availability of funds and number of applicants.
3. All decisions of the CFoM Scholarship Committee will be final.

## Eligibility Requirements

1. The applicant must be currently enrolled in the Chelmsford Public School System and be an active member in one of the **graded** performance band, chorus or orchestra programs offered by the Chelmsford School System.
2. The application and all documents are **due by Monday, May 1, 2023** to be eligible for consideration.
