

Chelmsford Friends of Music (CFoM) Camp Scholarship Application & Information

General Information

Camp scholarships are awarded to middle and high school students attending Music Summer Camp. THIS INCLUDES VIRTUAL CAMPS! These awards are meant to assist, not totally cover, the cost of tuition for a summer music camp. Programs from past years include UML Mary Jo Leahey Symphonic Band camp and UNH Summer Youth Music School, and Salve Regina Jazz Camp at Newport.

1. Scholarships are typically presented each year at the CHS Spring Pops Concert or the student's Middle School Spring Concert. However, presentation of this year's camp scholarships is still to be determined.
2. The number and value of the awards will be based upon the availability of funds and number of applicants.
3. All decisions of the CFoM Scholarship Committee will be final.

Eligibility Requirements

1. The applicant must be currently enrolled in the Chelmsford Public School System and be an active member in one of the **graded** music programs offered by the Chelmsford School System. Examples include: Band, Chorus or Orchestra.
2. The applicant must have performed a minimum of 4 hours of documented volunteer service to CFoM.
3. The application and all documents are due by Monday, May 1, 2023 to be eligible for consideration.
